<p>3:15 p.m. (15 minutes)</p> <p>ODCP – Scope of the next update and CRL comparison to other CNL sites</p> <p>Matt Waddington, Decommissioning & Environmental Specialist</p> <p>Victoria Shields, Decommissioning & Environmental Specialist</p>	<p>Matt Waddington, Decommissioning & Environmental Specialist, provided an overview on the scope of the next update of the Overview Decommissioning and Cleanup Plan (ODCP) and reminded the group of the ODCP update timeline. Matt walked the group through an ODCP Update GAP analysis and outlined 10 points that had been identified. Matt noted that he will provide the CAP with updates on the ODCP as the project progresses and as more information becomes available.</p> <p>No questions from the group on Matt's presentation.</p> <p>Victoria Shields, Decommissioning & Environmental Specialist, provided an overview of CNL's different sites, comparing the different site priorities and clean-up initiatives. Was content included related to commitments to long-term sustainability of the site/program to ensure safety/environmental health long-term. 3. What happens with all the existing contaminated areas (non-contained contamination). 4. Additionally, there was mention of already present environmental contamination of the area due to breakdown of historical containments. While there are separate documents and plans that address this, it was somewhat glossed over and these were not specifically included as already being actioned in the presentation - as well limited information on the impact/risk of this in the presentation. 5. There was a question/comment about the use of the term permanent in relation to the topic, and discussion on the Deep Geological Repository (DGR) and the associated timeframe. <p>All questions were answered during the meeting</p>
